Facilitation Goals. Create an environment for effective communication (the achievement of mutual understanding) Keep discussion focused; Keep people engaged. Advance and deepen discussion. Provide opportunity for all voices to be heard. Create environment of trust and support so disagreement and understanding can surface.

Barriers and facilitators of physical activity in knee and ...

Of all the facilitation guidelines, the most important may be to stay neutral. Do not lose your neutrality. Eliminate your personal bias and opinions from the discussion. The goal remains for the participants to provide answers or options, not you. Learn to expect hostility, but do not become hostile with your group or any participant.

Guiding conceptual framework. The Clinical Practice Guidelines Framework for Improvement [] and its updates [20,21,22] were used to guide the coding framework in the current study. Perspectives of health care professionals on the ...

The most frequently cited facilitators included esteem support from health care professionals and from peers, the need for greater involvement of the multidisciplinary team, and the relationship and trust between therapist and patient. Physical therapists who responded to the survey were able to recognize the challenges that patients faced.
