Title of page: Subtitle (if any). Retrieved Month Day, Year site was last viewed (if content is likely to change over time), from URL. If the content could change over time, include the Month Day, Year you viewed the site after the word "Retrieved" and before the words "from URL". Example.

When deciding how to cite your source, start by consulting the list of core elements. These are the general pieces of information that MLA suggests including in each Works Cited entry. In your citation, the elements should be listed in the following order: Author. Title of source. Title of container, Other contributors, Version, Number, Publisher,

Narrative citation: World Health Organization (2018) For a page from an organization's website without individual authors, use the name of the organization as the author. Provide as specific a date as possible for the webpage. Some online works note when the work was last updated.

MLA in-text citation for an online article Online articles don't usually have page numbers, so the in-text citation is just the author name in parentheses.

How to Cite a Website in MLA | In-text and Works Cited ...

Using In-text Citation Include an in-text citation when you refer to, summarize, paraphrase, or quote from another source. For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).

In-text Citation - APA Quick Citation Guide - Library ...

When citing a source with three to five authors, include all surnames for the first in-text citation, then use the first author's surname followed by et al. for subsequent citations. When citing six or more authors - use the first author's surname followed by et al. for all citations.

APA website citations usually include the author, the publication date, the title of the page or article, and the URL. If there is no author, start the citation with the title of the article. If the page is likely to change over time, add a retrieval date.

In this system, sources are briefly cited in the text, usually in parentheses, by author's last name and year of publication. Each in-text citation matches up with an entry in a reference list, where full bibliographic information is provided.

Chicago-Style Citation Quick Guide

Create in-text citations and place them in the body of your work. Then, create a list of full citations and place them at the end of the project. Label the page as "Works Cited." The good news is that references in MLA bibliography format and regular works cited references are structured the exact same way.

MLA Format and MLA Citations - Your BibMe Guide to MLA Citing

If there are four or more authors, list up to ten in the reference list; in the text, list only the first, followed by et al. ("and others"). For more than ten authors (not shown here), list the first seven in the reference list, followed by et al.
